# Drop Off to the Relevant Pavilion

## Entries close online Friday the 12<sup>th</sup> of July

**Art, Poetry, Writing, Craft, Needlework & Photography Entries:** Drop off 11am – 2pm Saturday prior to the Show (13<sup>th</sup> July). Judging commences shortly after, so they must be in by then.

**Cooking, Homebrew & Horticulture (Plants & Flowers) Agriculture entries:** Please drop off 10am – 12.30pm Thursday (18<sup>th</sup> July). Judging starts at 12:30pm, so they must be in! If you need to arrange, earlier drop off, please contact the show office.

**NEW RULE FOR HORTICULTURE** - Plant size cannot exceed pot size 5 LT, 22cms and 10kgs. Plants requiring a trolley to be transported will not meet the size requirements

## Poultry

**Poultry Entries:** Drop off 1pm – 7pm Wednesday (17<sup>th</sup> July). No fowl to be penned outside of these times unless under the direction of the poultry steward Craig Freaan.

**Poultry:** Can be collected from 4pm to 7pm on Saturday (20<sup>th</sup> of July), including poultry bought in the auction.

## Entry Slips

Entry slips **MUST** be printed and attached firmly to all entries before they are dropped off. Failure to do so will mean the entry will not be eligible for judging  
Entry slips can be found under the print tab on your online Show account

## Collection

**ALL ENTRIES in the general classes must be collected  
between 10am – 12pm on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> of July**

## Tips for entering online

- 1) Go to the Katherine Show webpage – [www.katherineshow.org.au](http://www.katherineshow.org.au)
- 2) Click on “My Account”
- 3) As we have a brand-new website, you will need to click “Register”. Input information to register a new account. If you are registering on behalf of a **SCHOOL, OR BUSINESS**, click the box “I am registering on behalf of a school or business”.
- 4) To purchase a pass to the show or to submit an entry for multiple people you will need to “Add Family Member” for each person you wish to buy a pass or submit an entry on behalf of.
- 5) To enter as a school, you will need to enter your School Name and the different Grades. For each grade you will be able to enter an individual student as a contact. \*For Class/Grade entries eg. “DS04 - Decorated Chook Silhouettes Group Primary School” you will need to add your Grade as an individual student. Eg. First Name: Grade 6, Last Name: School Name Gender: Leave Blank Age: Age of Grade. You will also need to add the school BSB and Account Number (this is for paying out prize money).
- 6) To enter as a business, you will need to enter your Business Name under School Name. To add entrant, click “Add School Grade”, retype Business Name (ignore age). Under Business Name/School Grade click Add New Student, here you can add in entrant from your business. You will also need to add your BSB and Account Number (this is for paying out prize money).
- 7) Once all family members/students/business entrants are added, you can start putting entries in your cart.
- 8) To nominate an entry, go to the ‘Entries’ tab and a menu should load.
  - Select the name of the person you are entering for in the first box. (Entrant must be under 18 to enter junior class)
  - Select what section you wish to enter in (eg. Agriculture, Art)
  - Select the division you wish to enter (junior, novice, etc.)
  - Select the specific class you wish to enter.
- 9) After all the details are in and are correct, click “Add to Cart”. This will put your entry in your cart to purchase and you can add as many entries as you like.
- 10) When you have all your entries in your cart, click on “View Cart” to review your purchases and checkout your items.
- 11) Once purchased, entry slips can be found under the ‘Print’ tab. Make sure you print out all the entry slips you purchase. Half of each entry slip is for you to keep. The other half is to be attached on your entry. It is **essential** you firmly attach the other half of the entry slip to your entry. Without it, the entry will not be judged. Lost entry slips can be reprinted from your account at any time.

## ART RULES

The following rules apply in addition to the General Regulations.

- Any article that has won a prize in a previous Katherine Show is not eligible to re-entry.
- All entries must be the work of the exhibitor and must be original in thought and composition.
- All entries must be delivered to Art Pavilion, between **11am – 2pm on the Saturday before Show Day (13<sup>th</sup> July)**. If you need to arrange, earlier drop off then please call the office.
- Any entry with a political agenda and/or logo may not be judged.



All paintings/drawings in open classes must be framed, with hooks and wire, ready for hanging; except Computer Generated Media which must be displayed as per the Photography rules on 'How to Present Your Photo'.

Junior entrants may use velcro on the back of their unframed artwork – only use the “hook” part of the velcro. *Entries without velcro (or are unmounted) will be asked to make a gold coin donation to cover costs to mount photo.*

Please attach the Entry Slip to the **FRONT** of your Artwork, otherwise we cannot judge it.

Please make sure there is no other identification on the front of your entry. If you have signed it, it must be covered over.

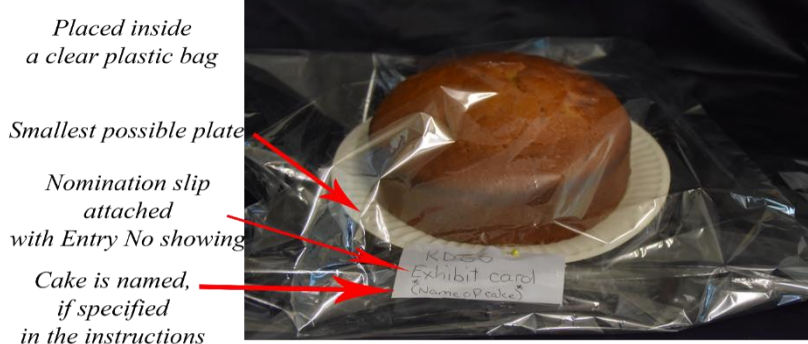

## COOKING RULES

The following rules apply in addition to the General Regulations.

- Entries are to be delivered to the Cooking Pavilion (below grandstand) between **10am – 12.30pm Thursday prior to Show Day (13<sup>th</sup> July)**.
- Any judges entering their own baking items must drop off entries at 12.30pm, to avoid seeing what participants have made prior to judging.
- The pavilion will be closed for judging from 12.30pm Thursday before the show.
- Cakes, pastries etc, which have been frozen, are acceptable.
- Please ensure lids are easily removed for judging.



- Present entries on the **smallest** possible plate or tray, place the entry including plate inside a large clear plastic oven bag is ideal. **Do NOT seal the bag**, do not use doilies, glad wrap, freezer bags or sticky tape. *Gold Coin donation is requested for all entries not presented correctly, to cover costs.*
- Please ensure your entry slip is attached to your exhibit and labelled with variety/flavour. **ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT THE ENTRY SLIP.**
- No icing, cream or dusted icing sugar is to be included unless specified.
- Dusted icing sugar on “Any variety” biscuit classes is permitted.
- Make sure you have the correct number of items on the plate and have included any other required information (e.g. list of ingredients for Damper).
- All cakes are to be made in a 20 - 25cm round cake tin unless specified.
- Fluted cutters and ring tins not permitted.
- Packet cake/biscuit/scone mixes **MUST NOT** be used as part of show entries.
- All Junior classes to be awarded First, Second & Third Prize where possible.
- **Sheila’s vs Blokes Cakes**
  - All cakes to be judged on presentation, texture and flavour.
  - Each section to be awarded First, Second & Third where possible.
  - Overall winner to be awarded Battle of the Sexes Title with Ribbon and Trophy.
  - Previous winners are not allowed to enter.
- Decorated Cakes are to be handwork only. Vase, pillars, ribbon, tulle, stamens and fine natural dried stems are permitted.

- **Jams/Preserves**

- All entries must be in screw top jars, preserving type jars, or bottles with lids; of 250 ml or greater.
- Attach (sticky tape or glue etc) the nomination slip to the **BASE** of the jar or bottle with the entry number showing.
- Write the entry number on the lid. Please loosen the lid, no wax tops or fabric covers.
- **PLEASE NAME THE VARIETY OF JAM/PRESERVE.**
- **All Jam & Preserve jars that cannot be opened will not be judged.**

- All entries must be collected between 10am – 12pm on the Sunday after the show. Entries not collected on Sunday will be disposed of the following day.
- Entrants **MUST** show proof of entry before collecting items – please bring your entry slip with corresponding name and entry number.
- The Katherine Show Society does not take responsibility for the consumption of any cooking entries after the show is complete. Please note that the cooking entries are not kept at regulated temperatures over the show weekend.

The following rules apply in addition to the General Regulations.

- Any article that has won a prize in a previous Katherine Show is not eligible to re-enter.
- All entries must be delivered to the Craft display area between **11am – 2pm the Saturday before the Show (13<sup>th</sup> July)**.
- **Lego/Duplo must be within measurement requirements. Maximum size; w 37cm/h 110cm/l 35cm**
- Entries that require hanging must have all requirements needed to be hung, e.g. string, rods, hooks etc. All other entries must be free standing or suitable for displaying inside our display cabinets. Items not suitable for displaying when they are dropped off will not be displayed and **cannot be judged**.



OK – less than 1.5m high and able to be moved by one person

OK, only if the article is prepared for hanging prior to dropping it off.

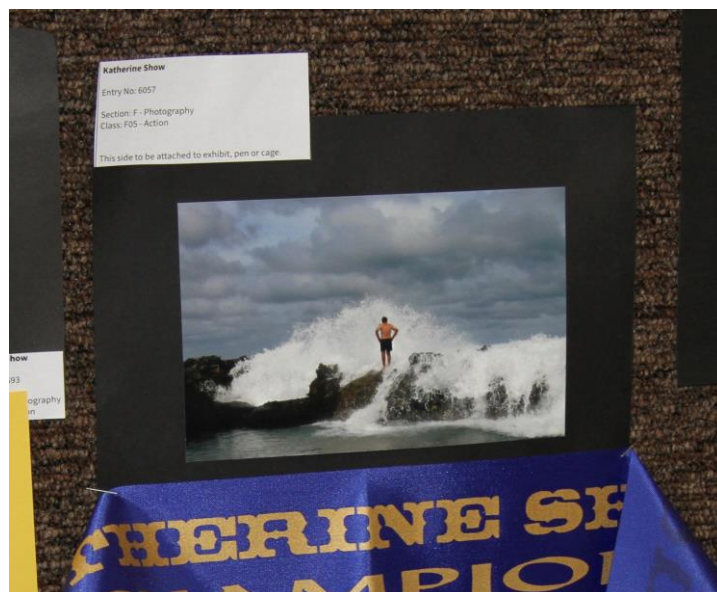

- Entries must be delivered to the Photography Pavilion between **11am – 2pm Saturday prior to Show Day (13<sup>th</sup> July)**.
- Entries must not have been entered in a previous Katherine Show.
- Photos in junior classes can be printed in any size. Sizes specified are indicative only.
- Entries must be **firmly attached** to a cardboard mount **as per diagram**. **NOTE:** Glue sticks do NOT work in our climate, use double sided tape or staples.



*Entry slip MUST be attached to TOP LEFT corner of entry*



*Hook velcro dots attached to all 4 corners*

Photos not mounted correctly will not be displayed and **cannot not be judged**.

Photos that have fallen off the border frame will not be displayed and **will not be judged**.

If the entry slip is not securely attached and falls off the photo, **it will not be judged**.

- Entries must be submitted with velcro on the rear of the photo frame for attaching to the wall. *Entries without velcro will be asked to make a gold coin donation to cover costs to mount photo.*
- Photos under glass or glass mounts are not acceptable and **will not be judged**.
- Photographs must be the work of the exhibitor.
- No identifying names or marks are to be visible on the displayed photograph

5. Fowl are to be penned between 1pm – 7pm, 17<sup>th</sup> of July NO fowl to be penned outside these times with-out the expressed permission of the Poultry Chief Steward.
6. Fowl to be collected between 4pm and 7pm, 20<sup>th</sup> of July. Fowl are NOT to remain past 7pm.

## Birds offered for Auction.

- Fowl offered for Auction are to be in a fit and healthy state.
- Sale of fowl is between Bider and vendor.
- A sale slip is to be completed prior to fowl being auctioned. (available from Stewards)
- Fowl entered in the show yet sold at auction MUST remain in their show pen until collection on the 20<sup>th</sup> of July (1pm – 7pm)
- It is advised NOT to try to sell lone roosters.
- Fowl NOT entered in the Show yet sold at auction will incur a \$2/Sale fee.
- Fowl sold at auction are expected to be PURE of type. If Fowl are X bred this is to be clearly expressed to Auctioneer.
