*Riders under the age of 18 MUST wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA events. Helmets must comply with current Australian & New Zealand safety standards & must be securely fastened under the chin at all times

*Children under the age of 17 must NOT ride a stallion on the grounds at anytime

*As per ACA Rules. NO Child on lead is permitted to compete or be in main arena while competition is on

*All Stallions are to be contained in accordance with ACA rule 11.12

*All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program

Horse Status: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exemption for Juniors, Juvenile, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates & Encouragment campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg. If one open horse competes then it is classed as an Open Draft)

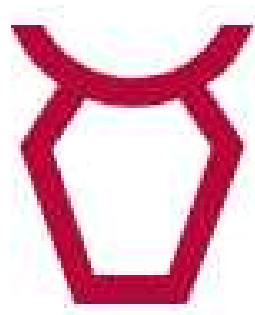

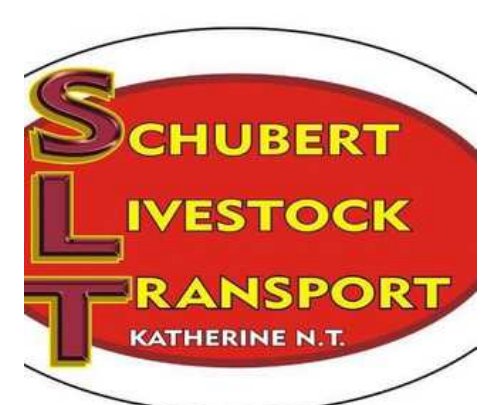
